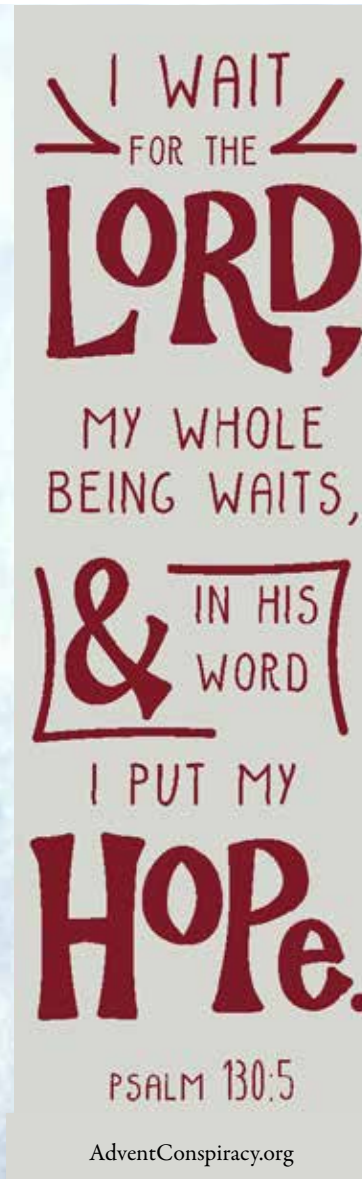
Something else to consider: Taking part in **Centering Prayer** as an **Advent discipline**. This is available every Thursday morning at 7:45 a.m. in the Gray House.
