# Download SaferWatch app to send, receive alerts at church



All Saints' has adopted the SaferWatch program and its accompanying mobile app as part of an initiative to enhance church security.

The SaferWatch app is a smart phone app that can be used to report suspicious activity or to receive such reports in real time. It is free to download and use, and instructions for downloading the app are printed at right.

The church's enhanced security program includes ALICE e-learning training from the ALICE Institute for clergy, staff and several parishioner groups. ALICE stands for Alert - Lockdown - Inform - Counter - Evacuate. The SaferWatch app offers an effective pathway for the "Alert" in ALICE.

All parishioners are encouraged to download the SaferWatch app. The ALICE e-learning training is also open for any individual to take at [www.alicetraining.com](http://www.alicetraining.com). Individual training carries a \$30 fee; the church is covering the fee for parishioner groups (such as ushers) which have been specifically requested to take the training.

**Learn more:** Aspects of our security program were detailed at an **Adult Forum** on August 11. If you missed it, the session will be repeated at **6:00 p.m. on Thursday, Sept. 12** in DeWolfe Hall. We encourage all to come learn more about keeping ourselves and our children safer at All Saints'.



## GETTING STARTED ON SAFERWATCH

### Step 1- Find the applications store on your mobile smart phone

#### Apple phone

Enter the "App Store" by clicking the blue icon on your phone's homepage

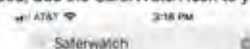
#### Android phone

Enter the "Play Store" by clicking the white icon on your phone's homepage



### Step 2- Locate and download the SaferWatch App

- Search for "SaferWatch" in the applications store, and download
- Once downloaded, add the SaferWatch icon to your phone's homepage



### Step 3- Create your SaferWatch account

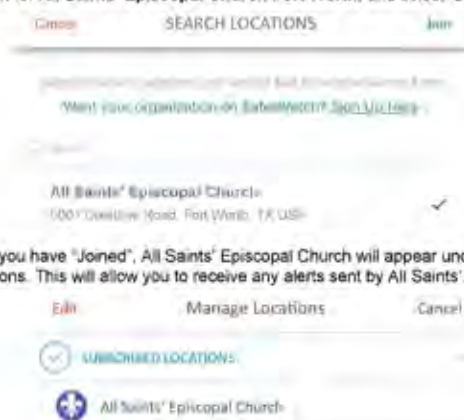
- Open the SaferWatch application by clicking on the icon to launch the application
- Input your name, email address, and any other requested information you'd like to provide
- Sign into the application successfully

### Step 4- Subscribe to Locations (your City, your Neighborhood, etc.)

- Click "Choose New Location" from the SaferWatch launch page



- Search for All Saints' Episcopal Church Fort Worth, and select "Join"



- Once you have "Joined", All Saints' Episcopal Church will appear under your Subscribed Locations. This will allow you to receive any alerts sent by All Saints'.

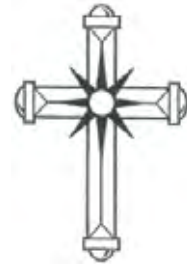

# Fall Bible Study's first five lessons will focus on 1st Timothy

Our Wednesday Bible Study for this fall will be the books of First and Second Timothy, two of the Pastoral Epistles.

We begin with First Timothy on **Wednesday, September 11**, taught by Mthr. Lynne Waltman.

Come and explore the First Letter to Timothy and learn why the Pastoral Epistles have been described as among the most valued and the most disparaged of the New Testament writings.

We'll delve into authorship of the book, the person of Timothy, and what the book has to say about church structure and discipline, truth, faith, and sound teaching.
